Our swimming program is in full swing for our Grade 1 to 4s and this is so important after some missed years.

High Abilities

We are very lucky to have a vast number of our students working above level in many areas due to our explicit teaching model. Our curriculum is pitched 12 months ahead of the Victorian Curriculum to cater for extension and differentiation within our classrooms.

This year saw the launch of the 'Create' program which is aimed at Grade 5 and 6 students who are working above the expected level in visual art. It was fantastic to see their enthusiasm, along with Claire Baker's, last week at their first session! They have some very exciting things planned for the year.



There will be many other opportunities for students to be extended in the other specialists' areas as the year progresses.

The Victorian Challenge and Enrichment Series (VCES) and Victorina High Ability Program (VHAP) offer opportunities for students from Grade 3 to 6. We also have extension groups for our younger students, including before school maths for Grade 4 and 5.
